Professional Skills

Product Development & Marketing:

Challenge: Develop a Summer Music Camp from ground zero with little to no network contacts.

Result: Built and successfully managed three profitable summer music camp businesses between 2009 and 2014 in Seattle, WA and Greenville, SC. Average camp attendance was 60 students in each camp generating revenues of \$18,000 each week.

Conducting & Coordinating:

Challenge: Assemble a musical ensemble with limited time resources.

Result: Assembled a summer orchestra at the University of Washington to perform in public the Summer of 2006. Created three ensembles at the University of South Carolina to perform three different concerts one of which featured Igor Stravinsky's notoriously difficult *L'Histoire du Soldat*.

Communication & Research:

Challenge: Develop relationships with many composers and scholars around the United States in a 6-month time-frame to gather data for a doctoral dissertation.

Result: Cross-referenced several sources in order to track down over 20 different scholars and conductors, whose data contributed to a new-to-the-field compendium of orchestral music composed and available by Black-American composers for the use of active conductors. Also served as a doctoral dissertation from the University of South Carolina.

Teaching & Training:

Challenge: Teach a music appreciation class of uninterested non-music major students at the University of South Carolina.

Result: Effectively engaged a lecture class of 100 to 150 so that 80% completed the end-of-term survey and the Outstanding Graduate Teaching Assistant Award was granted (one out of two across the University). Also recruited and trained four unpaid undergraduate assistants in the logistics and management of the class.
